The Long House, Salisbury Road, Breamore - Variation of conditions 2 & 3 of planning permission 22/10010 to allow amended materials to the frame of the carport:

Cllr G Hammond, proposed, Cllr H Hammond seconded and it was RESOLVED that Breamore Parish Council should select PAR 2 for this application. The Council would

recommend refusal but would accept the decision of the planning officer under the delegated powers on the grounds that it was disappointed that the materials set out in the plans had not been used which would have been consistent with the Breamore Parish Council Village Design Statement.

Application Nos. 22/11051 & 22/11052

Flood Street Farm, Flood Street, Breamore - Construction of a domestic extension to the existing house, with alteration of the existing connecting elevation to include a doorway within a former window opening and a first-floor window: Cllr Aggas, proposed, Cllr H Hammond seconded and it was RESOLVED that Breamore Parish Council should select PAR 5 for this application. The Council would leave the decision on this application to the planning and conservation officers under their delegated powers subject to their being satisfied that it was compliant with the Breamore Parish Council Village Design Statement.
